

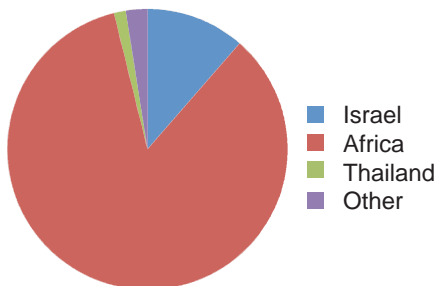

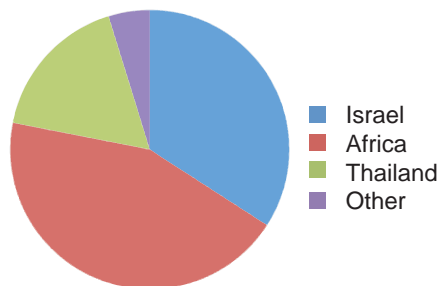

A WONDERFUL JOURNEY

It's been a wonderful journey that started at our regular Friday night Hesed Fellowship meeting on May 17, 2002, when I asked the question, "Who would like to join our proposed Op Shop Committee?" From that small beginning Neighbours Aid Community Stores was born.

Our progress with God's help has been amazing and our influence on so many lives is phenomenal. The goals in our incorporation state-

"To develop interest in and provide support for charitable work both in Australia and overseas in areas of needy childrens' health, education and economic provision."

Our Mission Statement says that *"We are a not for profit charitable organisation established to provide support for some of the world's most disadvantaged children"*.

In 2009 Neighbours Aid Community Stores distributed approximately \$394,700 to our various projects and partners. I'm delighted to report that our shops did extremely well with their distribution of \$219,800. Through the NACS GLOBAL arm of Neighbours Aid, we distributed \$174,900, which includes our child sponsorship programs in Malawi and Kenya. This made up some 44.8% of our total distribution for the year.

All NACS Accounts are audited by our accountants Russell and Wood at Maroochydhore. Our projects in Africa come under the auspices of Global Development Group, an Aus Aid accredited organisation. 6 monthly reports are submitted to them and our projects are visited each year by GDG representatives.

Thank you to all of our volunteers, managers, supporters and board members for your sacrificial work and dedication. These results could never have been achieved without your support.

Our future looks bright. We are doing what is right – feeding, educating, housing and nurturing some of the world's most vulnerable. In doing so, we are recycling donated goods and providing affordable clothing, furniture and other goods to our own community while also providing training in work skills for local unemployed.

This year promises to be one of expansion with our new Caloundra store open for business and a new store opening in the Strathpine/Lawnton area of Brisbane proposed for early this year. We have attained NGO status in Papua New Guinea and will open stores there as soon as we have our final paperwork through.
